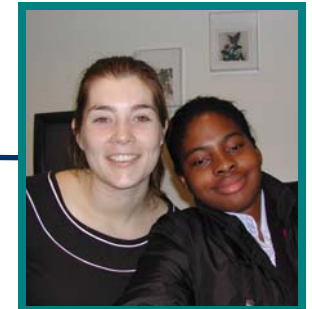

What is Rosedale?

The Rosedale Center for girls is one of two supplementary educational centers sponsored by the South Bronx Educational Foundation (SBEF).

Our after-school and summer programs help hundreds of girls and boys from the South Bronx to improve both academically and personally. 100% of our students graduate from high school, and more than 90% go on to college. SBEF students enter college at three times the rate of their peers.

These programs are made possible by the generous service of almost 100 professional and college volunteers.

How can I help?

Donate a few hours each week along with other young professionals and college students who share their time and talent with Bronx students. Most Rosedale volunteers serve as tutors, though you can volunteer in other ways— as a career speaker, field trip chaperone, or club leader. The Rosedale Center is located near the St. Lawrence Avenue stop on the 6 train, in the Parkchester area of the Bronx.

A typical time commitment for a tutor is one and a half hours a week. Tutors work with students in grades four through twelve. These students have the potential to excel in school with the guidance of a caring adult.
